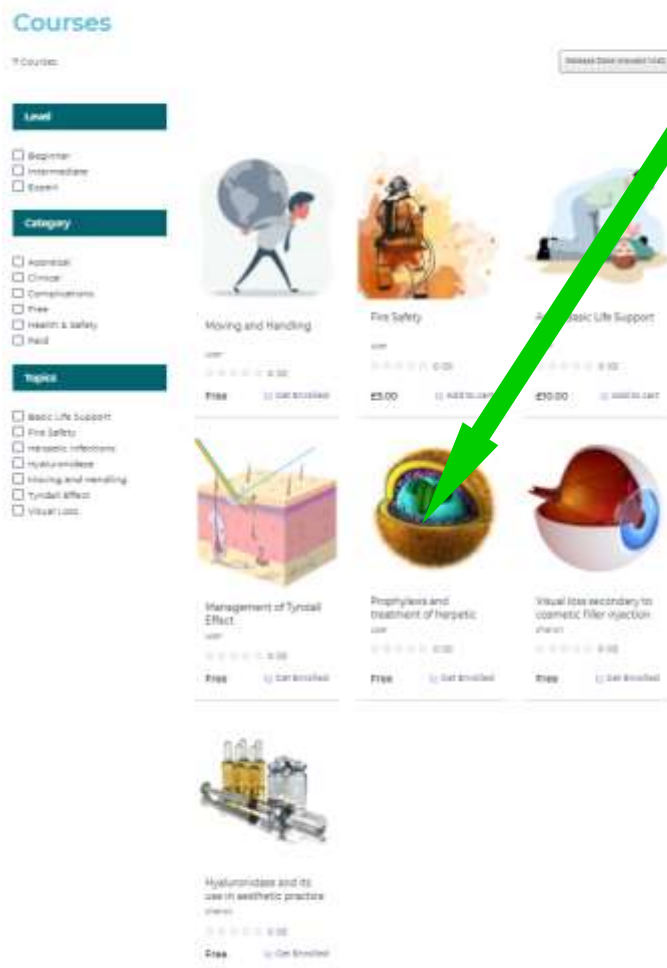



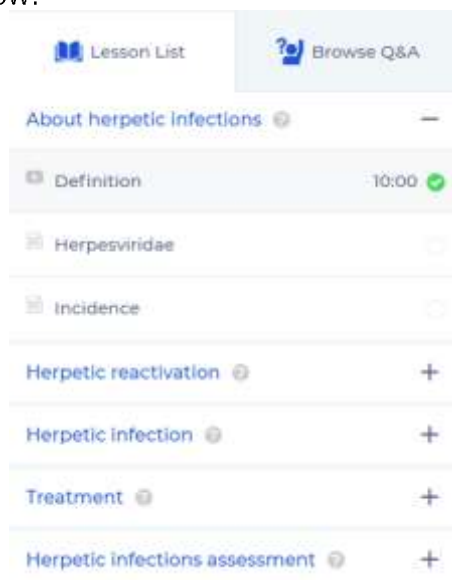
6. Once you clicked the “Complete Lesson” button, it will disappear, and a green tick will appear on the lessons list to the left to confirm that you have completed the lesson.

8. Once you have completed a lesson, ensure that there is a green tick next to the lesson on the left-hand lesson list as shown below:



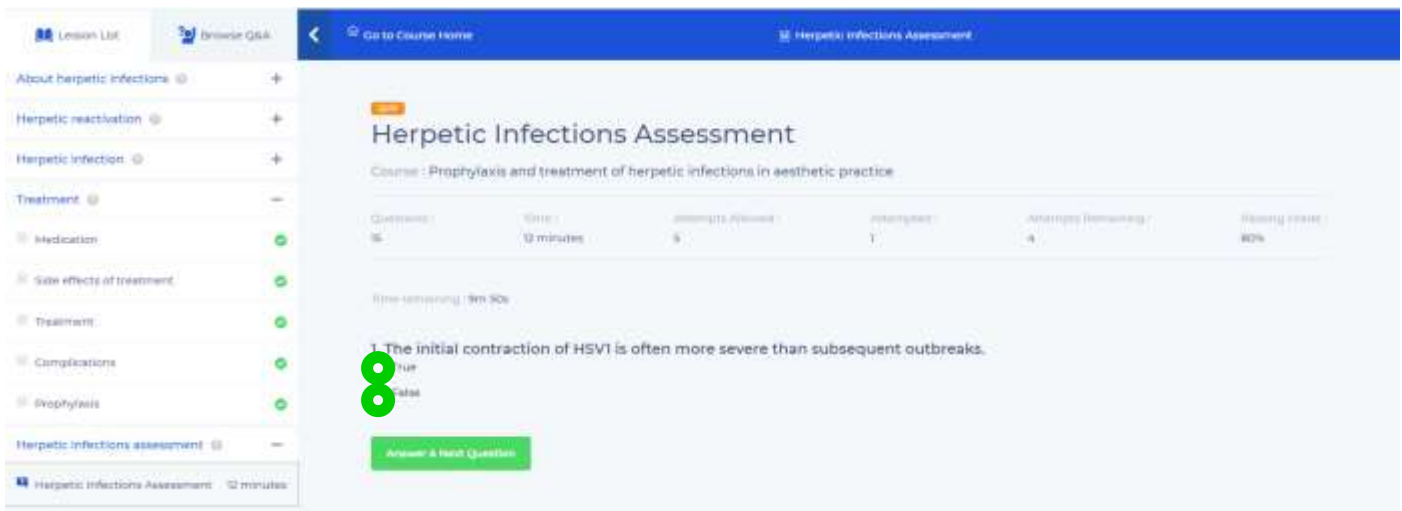
9. Once all lessons have been completed, the list should appear as below. You are then ready to proceed to the assessment.

10. Click on the “Start Quiz” button to begin the assessment. The information box would advise you on how many questions you are required to answer, the amount of time you have to complete the quiz, the number of attempts remaining if you failed to obtain a sufficient pass mark and the required passing grade.



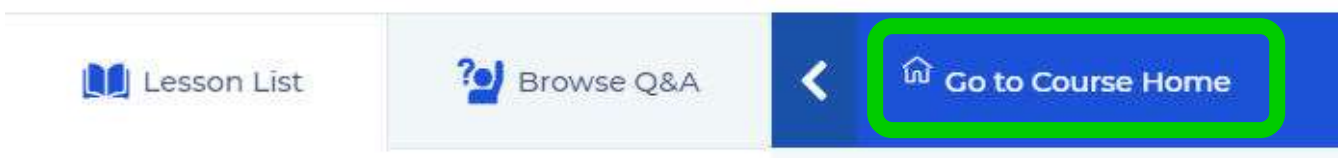
11. Once you have clicked “Start Quiz”, the timer starts, and you can complete all the questions. Questions and answers are randomly chosen and sorted so will vary each time the quiz is taken. Questions also take different formats including true or false, single answer, multiple answer, add the correct word and image sorting.



12. If you have successfully completed the assessment, a PASS will be displayed. If not, you will be allowed to re-attempt the assessment.



13. You now need to return to the main course page to obtain your certificate.



14. On the main course page, you will now see that the Course Status progress bar is 100% and there is a new box that has appeared “COMPLETE COURSE”.



If the progress bar is not 100% Complete, “CONTINUE TO LESSON” and identify which lesson does not have a green tick next to it on the list on the left and go back to this lesson and click the “COMPLETE LESSON” button.

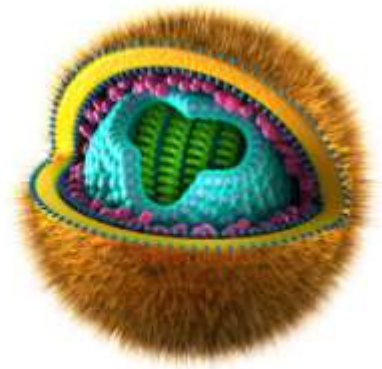
